




Simplified Deck Plan



Performance Deck Plan Option



The interior is clean and simple, with easy access from the cockpit. This takes you into the galley which is positioned amidships and can be worked from both port and starboard sides. Sleeping for eight with the forward berths converted to settees when required. A sail drive unit lies under the cockpit floor with good access for maintenance while good insulation will keep noise to a minimum. A forward enclosed head completes the layout. This will be a Racer that is comfortable for the longer offshore regattas or just the extended family holidays between races.
