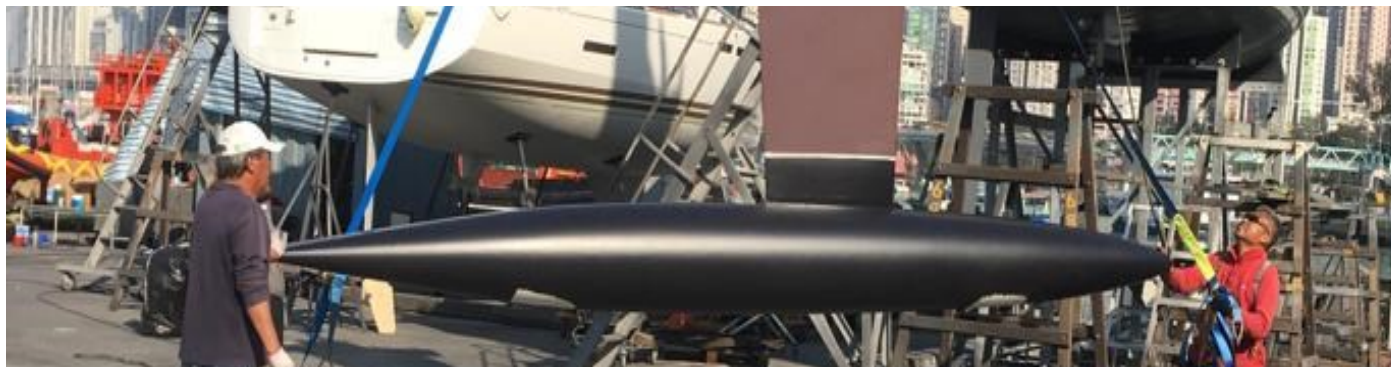

"The latest in our portfolio and we are near finalising the details for a first build. Cabot Lyman has long felt a modern, performance orientated yacht that had 'soul' was missing in the market. By using timber, Cabot felt that the 'soul' would return and distinguish the design from the production boats coming from places in and out of Europe. Most people equate wood with traditional design/builds, but we wanted to find that cross between modern and old that got everyone excited. The major push was for that missing 'magic factor, but the yacht had to be fast, easily and safely sailed offshore and be designed for the younger family to enjoy so shorthanded and simple were also key ingredients. We nailed the brief and hoping to send further updates throughout the year."
